Shimizu Corporation has been awarded in Singapore the construction of the new National Cancer Centre Singapore (NCCS) building.

On 2 June 2017, Minister for Health Mr Gan Kim Yong attended the groundbreaking ceremony for NCCS's new building. The new building is located on SGH Campus and is targeted to be ready by 2022.

The 24-storey building will house a new Proton Therapy Centre in the basement, providing an advanced type of cancer treatment that can target cancer with a much higher precision and fewer side effects compared to standard radiotherapy.
